

Adult & Teen Challenge of Sandhills, NC

COVID-19 Visitation & Pass Policies for May 30th – May 31st, 2020

On-Campus Visitations:

- Students will be limited to 1 visitor.
- The front gate will be opened at 11:45am and closed at 12:30pm.
- A checkpoint will be erected along our driveway to screen all incoming visitors.
- Each visitor's temperature will be taken twice with a noncontact forehead thermometer at the checkpoint. Each visitor will remain in the vehicle, while his or her temperature is being taken.
 - If both temperatures are recorded below 100.4 F, the vehicle will be allowed to proceed.
 - If either of the two temperatures is recorded greater than 100.4 F, the vehicle will be asked to park in a special area.
 - After 5 mins, the individual's temperature will be retaken twice.
 - If both additional temperatures are recorded below 100.4 F, the vehicle will be allowed to proceed.
 - If one of the two additional temperature checks are 100.4 F or above, the vehicle will be asked to leave the campus to seek medical advice from their primary care provider.
- Adult & Challenge of Sandhills, NC will supply each visitor and each student with a facemask, after their respective vehicle clears the temperature check.
- Each visitor will be required to wear their facemask at all times outside of their vehicle while on our campus.
- Each student participating in visitation will be required to wear a facemask at all times during visitation.
- Visitors will not be able to return to their vehicle, until they intend to leave the campus. Visitors may not leave the campus and then return, for any circumstance.
- Each visitor and student are encouraged to maintain a 6' distance from other's, per the CDC guidelines.
- Gifts/supplies for students will be limited to a volume of 4 grocery bags full. Please have items in grocery bags and bring items at beginning of visitation.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available, in addition to the soap and warm water found in the restrooms. Cleaning products will also be made available for surfaces.

Off-Campus Passes:

Departure

- The front gate will be opened at 8:45am and closed at 10am for departures.
- A checkpoint will be erected along our driveway to process all students departing on pass.
- Visitors will be required to remain in their vehicle while on our campus. Our campus restroom will be closed for visitors.
- Students will be called up one at a time to be checked out.
- Upon departure, Adult & Challenge of Sandhills, NC will supply each student with a mask. Each student will be required to wear the mask for the duration of time he is off campus.

Return

- The front gate will be opened at 3:45pm and closed at 5pm for returns.
- A checkpoint will be erected along our driveway to process all students returning from pass.
- There will be no physical contact or exchange of items between leadership and visitors, while checking in.

- Gifts/supplies for students will be limited to a volume of approximately 4 grocery bags full.
- Each student's temperature will be taken twice with a noncontact forehead thermometer at the checkpoint. Each student will remain in the vehicle, while his or her temperature is being taken.
 - If both temperatures are recorded below 100.4 F, the vehicle will be allowed to proceed.
 - If either of the two temperatures is recorded greater than 100.4 F, the vehicle will be asked to park in a special area.
 - After 5 mins, the student's temperature will be retaken twice.
 - If both additional temperatures are recorded below 100.4 F, the vehicle will be allowed to proceed.
 - If one of the two additional temperature checks are 100.4 F or above, the vehicle will be asked to leave the campus with the student to seek medical advice from his primary care provider.
- Upon return, each student will be sent to a designated area where he may properly be checked in. Each student will be required to wash his hands with soap and warm water and submit to a urine drug & alcohol screen.
